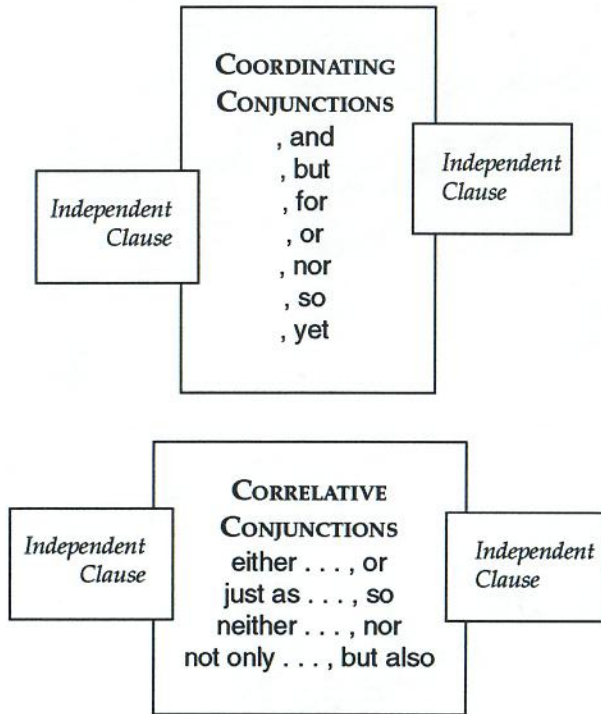


# CATEGORIES OF CONNECTORS

## I Connecting Independent Clauses

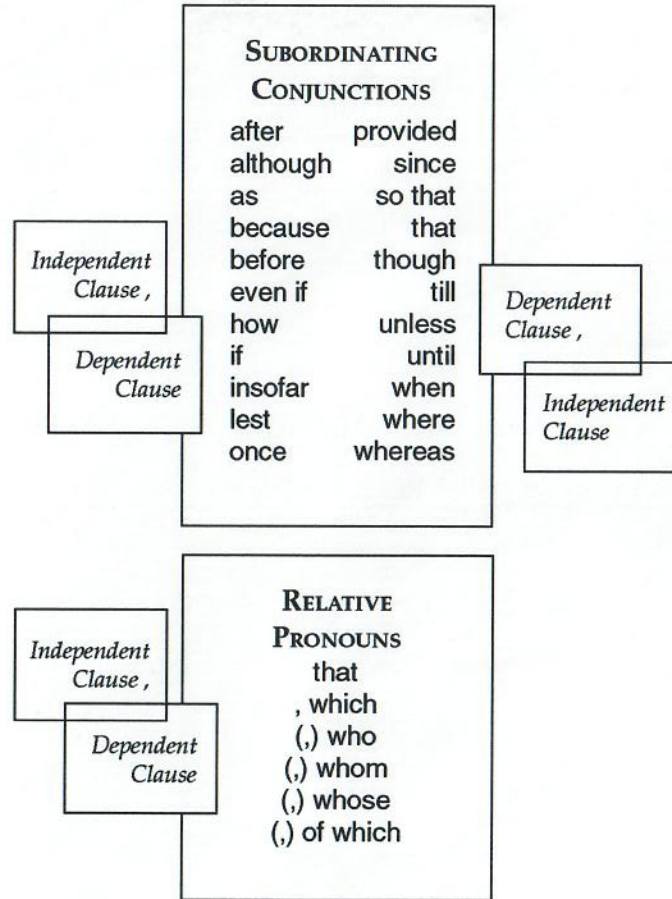


### COMPOUND SENTENCE

A sentence explains,  
**and** a bridge connects.

**Either** we accepted,  
**or** we would be refused.

## II Creating Dependent Clauses

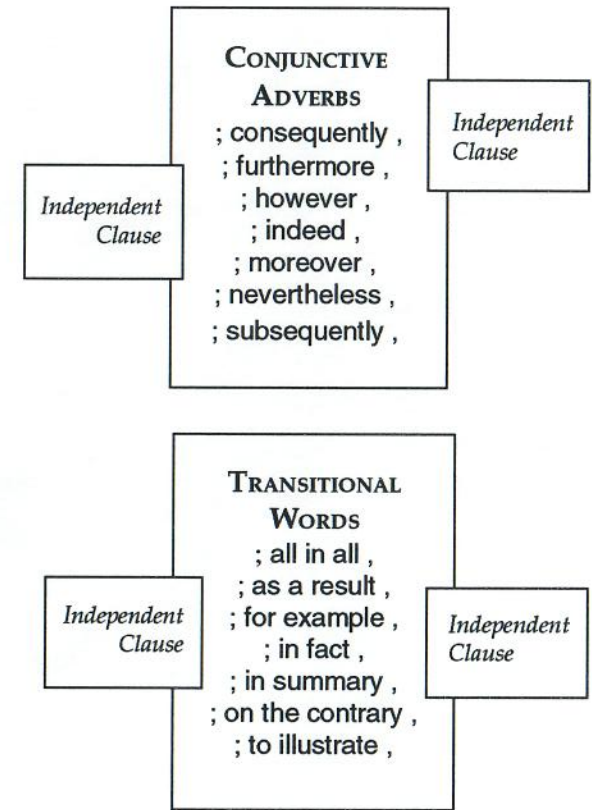


### COMPLEX SENTENCE

**Although** it was well designed,  
 the criteria had not been met.

He did not meet the criteria  
**that** had been set.

### COMPOUND SENTENCE COMPOUND-COMPLEX SENTENCE

This design was well done;  
**consequently**, it was accepted.

The design had appeal; it was,  
**in fact**, accepted.
